Iran's textile industry has a history that stretches back to the 11th and 12th centuries, when the country was one of the world's premier exporters of textiles and silks to Europe, Asia and the rest of the world.

Over a hundred years ago the first textile mill operating with European machinery was established in the Iranian capital Tehran, and today, Iran's textile and clothing industry accounts for more than 25 per cent of its industrial employment and makes up for more than 30 per cent of exports.

The country's textile companies are mostly based in the central provinces such as Yazd and Isfahan as well as the cities of Tehran and Qazvin, while there are also a lot of units in the Northern provinces and Azerbaijan.

Exports include garments, cotton and cotton-blend fabrics, and floor coverings. Iran features in the list of the world's top 20 textile investment opportunities, and industry experts are convinced there is still a wealth of untapped potential in Iran's textile and clothing industry just waiting to be discovered by overseas investors.



Why Isfahan?

- The volume of Iran's clothing market is about 15 billion dollars in three branches:
 - wearable
 - Home textiles
 - Technical textiles
- Iran's textile and clothing imports are about 3-5 billion dollars per year
- Isfahan ranks first in Iran with more than 50% of textile production
- More than half of Iran's textile factories need reconstruction and renovation
- Iran is a big market for paints, chemicals, and technical parts, which has intensified due to political and economic sanctions
- Isfahan is the most industrial province of Iran with 12% of the country's industries
- Isfahan has been the capital of the Iranian Empire twice in the past 1500 years, and the valuable works of both periods can be visited.
- The spring season in Isfahan with its unique tourist attractions in various fields of tourism such as health tourism, historical and artistic tourism, food and culture tourism, industrial tourism, etc. is the first destination of many foreign tourists.
